Context

The project **Mitigation Enabling Energy Transition in the Mediterranean Region (meetMED Project)** has been developed by the Mediterranean Association of National Agencies for Energy Management (MEDENER) and by the Regional Centre for Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency (RCREEE), and is financed by the European Commission as part of the EU Energy and Climate Diplomacy for two years from May 2018 until April 2020.



MEDENER is an international no-profit organization gathering agencies from North and South of the Mediterranean region in charge of implementing public policies on energy efficiency and promotion of renewable energy sources.
