Hosted by the Tunisian National Agency for Energy Management (ANME), the meetMED workshop on Energy Efficiency in Buildings is co-organized by ANME (Tunisia), ADENE (Portugal), ADEME (France), ALMEE (Lebanon) and RCREEE, as part of the activities of **meetMED (Mitigation Enabling Energy Transition in the Mediterranean Region)** project - an EU-funded project developed by the Mediterranean Association of National Agencies for Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy (MEDENER) together with the Regional Centre for Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency (RCREEE).

Invited participants are the national experts on Energy Efficiency in Buildings from the respective taskforce of the **meetMED workshop Regional Expert Network (REN)** established in 2018.

The discussion and the conclusions of the workshop will contribute to the meetMED report on Energy Efficiency in Buildings in the meetMED countries: Algeria, Egypt, Greece, Italy, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Palestine, Portugal, Spain and Tunisia.
