Policy conclusions and recommendations

Policy conclusions and recommendations are a crucial part of the MICR. The combination of general and specific recommendations should guarantee both long-term policy advice and short-term policy guidance for the improvement of investment climate and market structure. The policy conclusions and recommendations should include:

- Encouragement of specific developments and or recommendations of specific initiatives;
- Roadmap or timeline cooperation.

Preliminary elements for policy recommendations

- To establish a specific regulatory framework to enable financing with low interest rates for EE and RES initiatives;
- Availability of low-interest rate for Local authorities in order to support RES production and EE implementation.
- Overcome the current structure in the electricity sector in order to increase competitiveness;
- Making RES more competitive by reducing production costs;
- Support consumers to better understand and cut their energy bills guiding their consumption towards efficiency criteria;
- Promoting public opinion in favour of EE and RES
