## ***Description of the Activity 3.1***

The activity addresses policy and regulatory risks and barriers for the financing of EE and RES in the Mediterranean countries, by gathering updated information on the national economy, in particular the investment climate in the energy sector, the energy market structure, successful business models and the legislative framework for EE and RES investments.

# ***MEETMED Investment Country Report (MICR)***

The main outcome is an Investment Country Report, aimed at giving a brief and up-to-date picture of the EE and RES markets of two representative Mediterranean countries: ALGERIA and PALESTINE

The meetMED country reports on RES and EE investment climate provide for transparent and comprehensive analysis of the existing legal and regulatory framework applicable to (foreign) investment in the energy sector.

The country report may include policy recommendations.
