Background

Under the auspices of the Union for the Mediterranean, this event will gather the national experts who are members of the UfM REEE Platform Working Group on energy efficiency (EE) in Appliances established in January 2019 (at the annual meeting of the UfM Energy platforms), and of the meetMED taskforce on EE in Appliances.

The members of Working Group will contribute to the event by preparing country questionnaires and discussing them in session 5, and by commenting the Terms of Reference for the Working Group in session 6.

The questionnaire and the Terms of Reference, prepared by the meetMED team, will be distributed in advance to the members.

The outcomes of the country questionnaires and will be further elaborated in a meetMED regional report.

The sessions will have a specific focus on regulatory and institutional aspects; monitoring and evaluation processes and structures; energy efficient air-conditioning systems; possible replacement and appliances' scrapping systems; barriers to trade and investments in energy efficient appliances.
