RCREEE is an intergovernmental organization aiming to enable and increase the adoption of renewable energy and energy efficiency practices in the Arab region.

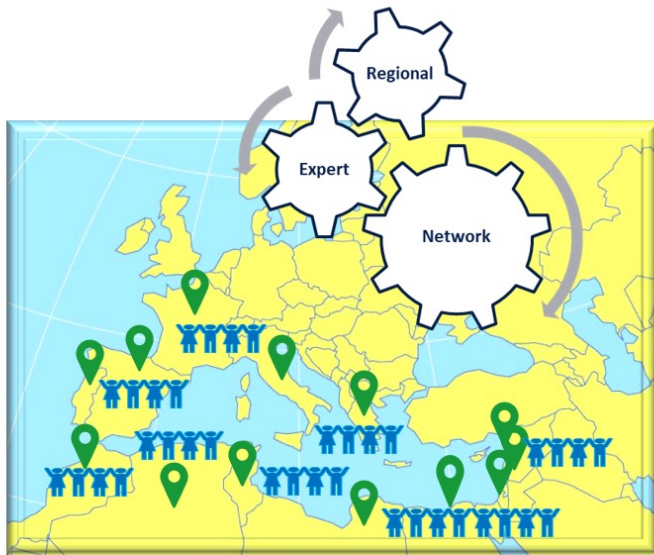

meetMED REN reached more than **70 national experts** (II phase: **more than 120**) from national energy agencies and departments of **13 Mediterranean countries**.

The meetMED REN consisted of **four thematic task forces**, engaged in implementing the project's objectives:

- EE and RE strategies and policies;
- EE and RE monitoring tools;
- EE in buildings;
- EE for appliances.

The meetMED REN experts strengthened **technical expertise to support national governments to implement EE and RE policies and measures**.

Together, they created instruments shared at regional level,
such as policy recommendation.

Contribute to **enhancing energy security** of beneficiary countries while fostering their **transition to low carbon economy**, thereby contributing to more stable, **efficient, competitive and climate-resilient** socioeconomic contexts.



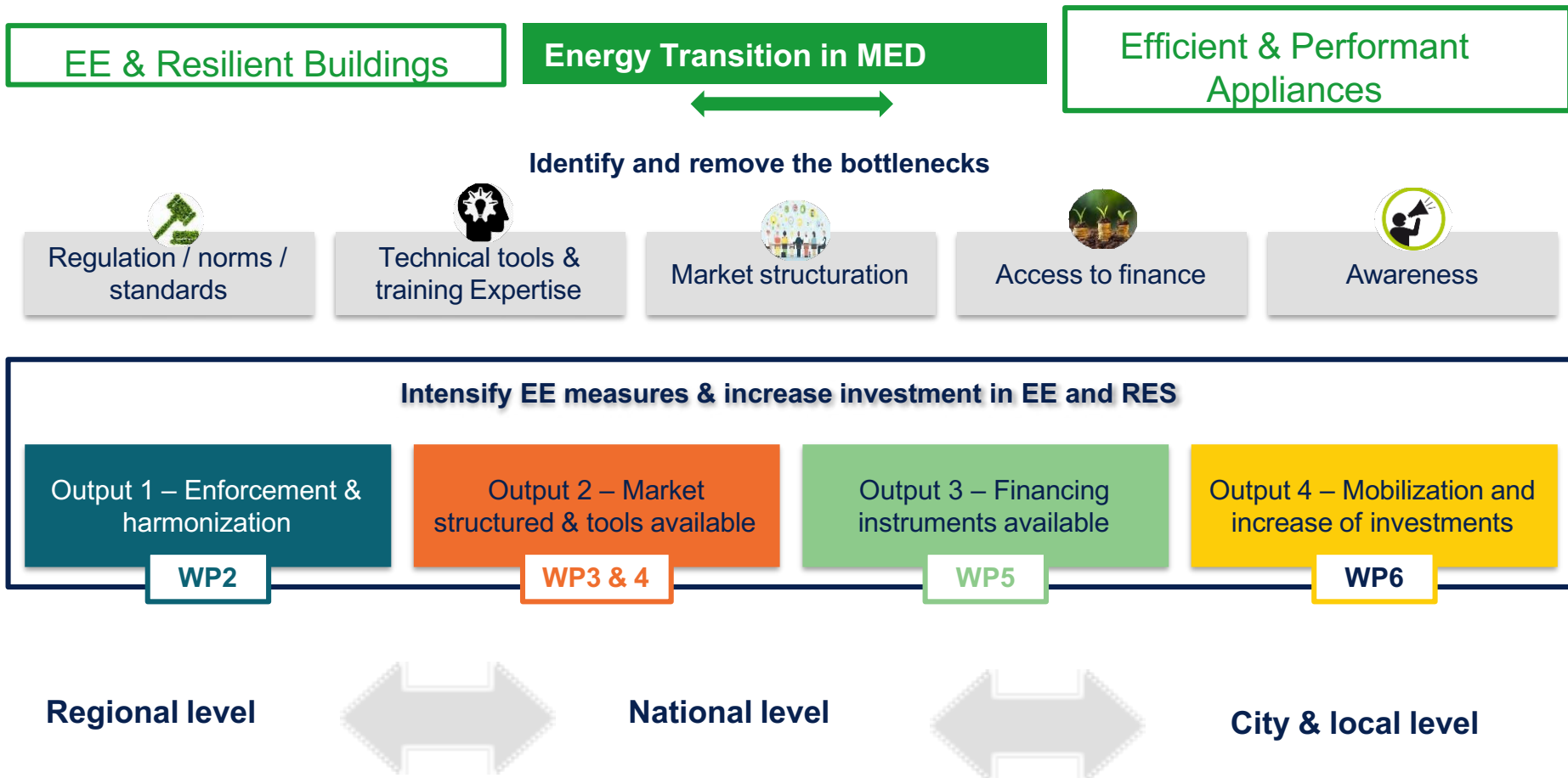
