
## **Objectives**

- Providing tools and methodologies to agencies to allow them to better support municipalities in implementing EE actions
- Tools such as: audits, guidance on construction & renovation, including passive solutions, urban heat management, one-stop-shops to spread good practices in the private housing sector, capacity-building, etc.
- Some tools & methodologies are already experimented in countries: Tunisia, Algeria, Morocco, Lebanon have success stories to share and replicate in other countries


