


Key Findings from MeetMED-I

- Electricity consumption trends from the MeetMED-I project shows that
 Residential sector consumes ~42% of the total end electricity use in the
 SEMCs.
- Appliances contribute to 70% ~ 80% of the total residential consumption in the ESM region.
- Comparative Labelling is the predominant in the SEM region while
 Mandatory MEPS are the most applied
 tool in use by the governments.
- However there is variance in maturity of implementation between different countries.
- Key challenges to the promotion of efficient appliances include need for supporting policies & guidelines, Implementation of MVE and Public
 Awareness

WP4 in few words: Promote Efficient Appliances & Develop the Market WP4 Objectives


- WP4 focuses on promoting the use of energy efficient appliances in the SEM Countries in order to help in the global energy security & contributes to economical growth.
