Energy Transition in Jordan

- The government establishes clear energy transition policies outlining goals, targets, and timelines for increasing the share of renewable energy and improving energy efficiency.
- JREEEF was established under bylaw49/2015 Its mission typically revolves around advancing renewable energy adoption and promoting energy efficiency.







National Energy Efficiency Action Plan

 The ministry has developed the first, second, and third editions of the NEAP, by focusing on end-users of energy and integrating the transportation sector into its strategy, the third edition of clean energy initiatives aims to triple renewable energy and double energy efficiency by aligning with the ambitious goals set forth in COP28 outcomes. This comprehensive approach addresses the interconnected challenges of climate change, energy security, and sustainable development while unlocking new opportunities for economic growth and prosperity.





Jordan Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Fund/JREEEF

- Total JREEEF investment in energy projects and programs reached 70 million JOD.
 - 50 million for RE.
 - 20 million for EE.
- JREEF developed and launched (2024-2030) strategy which aligned with:
 - The national energy sector's strategy
 - Ministry of Energy & Mineral Resources Strategy.
 - National Goals and NDCs
 - Economic Modernization vision
 - Green Growth National Action Plan
 - National Energy Efficiency Action Plan







JREEEF in Energy Efficiency

- JREEEF has introduced, opened, and regulated the market in EE.
- With the licensing framework in place, the market is opened up to licensed companies to offer their services to businesses, industries, and residential consumers.
- Companies can have :
 - Energy Audit license.
 - ESCO + Energy Audit





JREEEF in Energy Efficiency

- JREEF implemented Pilot projects with the ESCO model in the tourism sector for targeted hotels in Petra and in Aqaba.
- JREEEF is Developing an Energy Performance Contract (EPC) based on sharing or guaranteed savings as a proactive step to ensure the success and sustainability of Energy Service Company (ESCO) projects while protecting the interests of all parties involved.
